A Wild Goose “Classic” Circa 1984

This fruit forward Riesling comes from grapes grown throughout the Okanagan Valley, including the 35 year old Wild Goose vines and the 12 year old Secest vines. Careful vineyard management and hand harvesting allows the wine to express not only the vine’s age but also the unique soil in which they grow. This wine can be cellared for 5-10 years, peaking around 3-5 years. Sweet reserve is added to balance the refreshing racy acidity, a “classic” method of winemaking.
