

2016 **Pinot Noir** Okanagan Valley

"Pinot Noir...the Heartbreak grape"

The nose on this classic Pinot Noir will immediately bring up visions of dark cherry, anise and raspberry. The oak influence is felt on the nose and palate, with subtle lingering flavours of vanilla and light ruby red in colour. From the Artemisia Vineyard in Naramata this wine was chosen as the best Pinot Noir at the Cascadia wine competition in Washington State, including wines from BC, Oregon, Washington, and Idaho.

Nose: Cherry and raspberry

Palate: delicate bing cherry, soft silky tannins
